The TPB exposure draft information sheet outlines the relevant experience requirements for registered tax (financial) advisers. AIST supports the requirements as drafted in this sheet and welcomes this as vital guidance.

AIST welcomes this guidance which outlines the TPB's interpretation of 'relevant experience' for the purposes of registration as a tax (financial) adviser. We believe that the guidance provided is both practical, and welcome.

We note that this applies to the standard registration regime which doesn't come into effect fully until 2017. We believe that this should be sufficient time for the requirements to be met, as proposed in this exposure draft.

Lastly, we welcome the provisions of paragraphs 16 and 17, which allow for the fact that the TASA requirements are new for financial advisers.
