AIST Assessment remark fee policy



Purpose

The AIST Assessment remark fee policy defines AIST's position in relation to circumstances where a student is required to pay a remark fee for resubmitted assessments.

This policy relates to students enrolled in any course that forms part of AIST's Diploma of Superannuation (FNS50715), those courses being:

- RG146 for the superannuation industry
- Insurance for the superannuation industry
- Investment for the superannuation industry

Course assessment

The assessment for all Diploma of Superannuation (FNS50715) courses consist of one exam and one assignment.

Remark fee

If a student does not achieve the required pass mark of 80% for each assessment on the first attempt, they will be permitted a second attempt at no additional cost.

If a student does not successfully complete their assessment on the second attempt, they will be permitted a third and final attempt and will be required to pay a remark fee of \$125. AIST will issue an invoice by email for the payment of this fee and the fee must be paid before assessment results are released.

If a student does not successfully complete their assessment on the third attempt, they will be deemed 'not yet competent' and their enrolment in the course will expire.

Once a student's course enrolment has expired, students who still wish to complete their course will need to re-enrol and pay the full course fee.
